Tennessee Waste Reduction and Recycling Act: TWRRA

TN Bill # SB0573/HB0550 Senator Heidi Campbell/Rep. Torrey Harris

Tennessee has a packaging waste problem that has outgrown the capacity to handle it.

Tennessee sends

900,000 tons

of packaging waste to landfills per year

690 pounds

of packaging waste to landfills per TN household per year

Tennessee ranks **48th** in U.S. with a **12%** recycling rate

Only **47%** of TN residents have access to recycling



Only 12 % of recyclable material is recycled in Tennessee

88% of recyclable material is landfilled



The recycling infrastructure has not kept up with the growth of flexible packaging












E-commerce has exacerbated waste





Source of packaging waste? All of this packaging has to go somewhere..



To recycle today's volume of packaging waste a \$220 million investment into TN recycling infrastructure is needed

- Equitable recycling for every home: **\$80 million**
- Residential recycling solutions for film & flexibles: \$80 million
- New or upgraded material recovery facilities: \$60 million



Who's responsible?

We all are.

Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) provides a way for us:

- to do what's right
- to clean up our own mess
- to share the responsibility

Lack of funding is the **#1** obstacle keeping us from expanding recycling

EPR funds the investment to improve recycling

What is Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR)?

EPR is the legislation that provides a sustainable funding source to improve and expand the existing recycling infrastructure.

Key Facts about EPR...

- Transfers cost of recycling from local governments to the brand, aka. (producer) who's packaging enters Tennessee's waste stream to be recycled.
- Improves overall recycling by diverting valuable material from landfills and expanding recycling to all residents
- Establishes a PRO (a 5013c Producer Responsibility Organization) – "The Heart"
- 4) EPR legislation varies from state to state and country to country.

EPR incentivizes and encourages through eco-modulation:

- Reduction of packaging material
- Use of recyclable packaging material
- Use of recycled content material
- Reusable packaging


Incentives that reduce Producers overall packaging cost - the smaller the package the lower the cost

Studies show no correlation between EPR legislation and increased consumer costs

* Proposed full packaging EPR legislation did not advance.




What's a PRO?

A Producer Responsibility Organization is a group of companies brought together to create, implement & manage the EPR plan

The Heart of EPR is The PRO

The PRO is overseen by



Contracts with counties and current waste haulers and pays recycling service providers Conducts statewide needs assessment of current recycling systems utilizing existing infrastructure

Proposes reduction & recycling rate goals and timelines

PRO Responsibilities

Reports to Advisory Board of key stakeholders and Government Agency

Funds recycling education programs Collects annual dues from producers based on amount & type of packaging

Circular Action Alliance (an established PRO)
